5. Putting the Ball in Play-Live Ball

Addition

5.11 When a ball is hit into the outfield and becomes lodged in the fencing the defensive player/buddy will immediately notify the field umpire by hands in the air to signal the ball is stuck. All play will be stopped by the umpire. This will be considered a ground rule double for the batter. Runners will advance as instructed by the umpire.

5.12 The object of Challenger baseball is to teach basic fundamentals which include batting, throwing the ball, catching the ball, and making plays in the field. In this regard, all fielders will attempt to throw the ball to each other. Buddies will assist players using wheelchairs or walkers with catching and throwing the ball. At all times, the player is expected to play the game according to his ability; the buddy is there to assist only. There is no rolling of the ball in the field to another player to make a play. The ball is to be thrown.

8. The Pitcher
