The spring season of Miracle League baseball begins Tuesday, March 18, 2014. Intermediate games are scheduled Tuesday nights at 7:15 pm and Thursday nights at 7:15 pm. The advanced teams will play on Wednesday nights at 7:15 pm. All non competitive teams play at 9:30 am on Saturdays.
